



ATLANTA BETTERMENT GRANT GUIDELINES

Deadlines:

- **Grant Applications are due by March 20, 2017**
- **Checks will be distributed by April 15, 2017 or according to the time frame contained in the accepted proposal.**

General Conditions:

Any group submitting an application must be an officially registered not-for-profit organization with 501(c)(3) status. All materials submitted become the property of the Atlanta Betterment Grant Program Reviewing Committee. Grant applications will not be returned. Information contained in applications may be shared with third parties and outside groups, organizations, and entities as the Reviewing Committee feels are appropriate. The Reviewing Committee, or any member thereof, may request additional information and/or interviews to assist in the committee's review and evaluation of the application.

The Reviewing Committee reserves the right to reject any and all applications, in whole or in part, at any time and from time to time, in its sole discretion. There is no guarantee that any particular project or organization will receive funding.

None of the money given as a grant can be used for the support of any political campaign, election activities or other political activity. If there are significant changes to the requesting group's structure or personnel during the grant period, then this shall be promptly brought to the Reviewing Committee's attention.

Grantees are responsible for the proper expenditure of funds and for maintaining adequate supporting records to provide full and complete disclosure of the use of the funds in bettering the Atlanta community. All grantees are responsible for completing and submitting a Final Report. Grantees must also report on any grants received from other funding sources for their project, including the amount received and the funding source.

Preference in awarding grants will be given to those organizations that provide matching funds for their project, as well as those that submitted Final Reports for grants received in the past.
