## Meeting Minutes

### January 16, 2020

**OPEN:** The January 7<sup>th</sup> meeting reconvened on Tuesday January 16, 2020 at 7:30 PM at Atlanta City Hall. The meeting was called to order by Mayor McVey at 7:30pm.

Chief Eimer gave us a short report on Cannabis information given to the council and the public on Facebook. The new computer system was functioning.

The Mayor reported on a meeting held on Hazard mitigation plan in the County. A plan was outlined that would allow grant applications from the federal government.

Cheek entered the meeting at 7:43 pm

Rural water was in town and detected a major leak that was fixed. They will be back to check sewers.

Keith Moran was present to discuss several aspects of TIF and explain the potential business district program.

A proposal B. District was given to the council. Moran explained financing and uses for funds. Other community tax rates were compared. An increased rate would not be out of line.

Activities in other towns were outlined. Building repairs and restoration were common. Areas to include in the Business district were discussed. Exemptions to the tax was all gone over.

Specifications of setting up the business district was explained as well as cost.

Concerns about increased taxes were voiced by Alderman Young.

Income estimation were gone over. Projections were about 94,000.00 in revenue from the district.

Evans asked about a police question pertaining to the County. The Sheriff felt that the County was in Atlanta to often and wanted to curtail their services. More information will be sought on the topic.
