Alderman Young reported the improper parking on Arch St. near Chubbys. Signs will be ordered to require parallel parking.

The Mayor brought up silt removal at the Golf Course pond used for irrigation. The job will take 2-3 days and cost not to exceed \$10,000. Young asked some questions about how the water was used for irrigation.

The council took up the annual payment to Logan County Economic Development Partnership in the amount of \$3298.00 or \$2 per person based on population.

Alderman Eimer asked if the amount was for the year? Mayor stated it was.

Alderman Young felt the money would be wasted.

Alderman Colaw felt it was worth participating as the Partnership was a big reason the Truck Stop is going in Atlanta.
