

Atlanta City Council Public Meeting Minutes March 3, 2020

OPEN: A Public Hearing for the Establishment of a Business Development District in Atlanta was held on Tuesday March 3, 2020 7:00pm.

Keith Moran, TIF Administrator, was present to conduct the public hearing required for the formation of a Business District for Atlanta.

Sales Taxation within the District was explained. Taxation would go from 7.75% to 8.75% if implemented. Money could be spent within the District only.

The District would roughly follow the TIF District but not exactly. The District must qualify to enter the program. Money can only be spent for certain items and these were outlined broadly.

Timing of implementation of the program was explained.

Q. Would money go to streets or to the business. It could be used for both.

Rules should be put in place to govern who can be given the money on a nondiscriminatory basis.

The process to date was explained. A discussion ensued on the criteria for allocating money to those who request it.

Alderman Young felt there was a parcel on the map should not be included in the map of the district because it belonged to the state. This will be checked.
