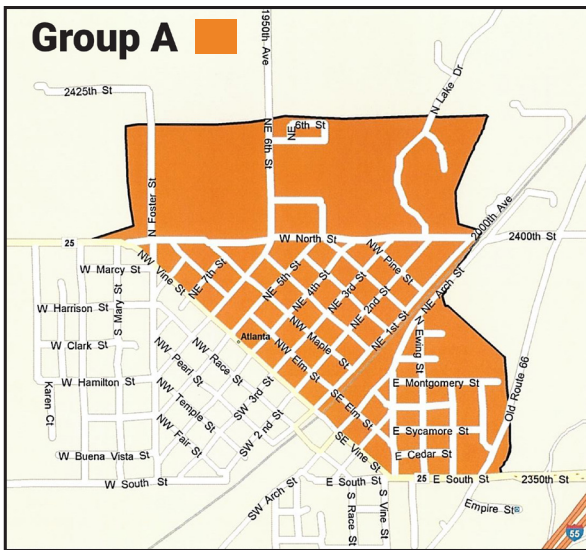


# Atlanta Trash PickUp Calendar

Please put out your carts the evening before or by 4:30 am in the morning and be patient as collection times will vary.

## Curbside Recycling Simplified

Republic collects all recyclable material such as cardboard, paper, metal cans, plastic bottles, jugs and bottles. **All containers are to be empty and rinsed. Please do not bag your recycling before putting it in your container.** For more information, please visit <https://recyclingsimplified.com>.

### Do Recycle:

- Aluminum Cans, Trays & Foil: Trays and foil must be cleaned
- Aseptic Packaging & Gable Top Containers: milk and juice cartons
- Steel Cans and Tins: including aerosol cans
- Glass Bottles and Jars: clear, brown, and green. NO Window glass, dinnerware, or ceramics.
- PLASTIC CONTAINERS:
  - #1 Soda, Water, & Flavored Beverage Bottles (#1 clear and green)
  - #2 Milk & Juice Jugs (clear)
  - #2 Detergent & Fabric Softener Containers (colored)
  - #3 Narrow Neck Containers Only (health & beauty aid products, household cleaners)
  - #4 Grocery Containers (margarine tubs, frozen dessert cups, six and twelve pack rings.)
  - #5 Grocery Containers (yogurt cups and narrow neck syrup and ketchup bottles)
  - #7 Plastic Narrow Neck Containers Only.
- Plastic buckets Such as kitty litter buckets. (5 gallon maximum size)
- Newspaper, including inserts (remove plastic sleeves)
- Cardboard
- Kraft Bags (brown paper bags)
- Magazines, Catalogs, & Telephone Books
- Office & Computer paper, notebook, school, & gift wrap
- Chipboard (cereal, cake & food, gift boxes, etc.)
- Carrier Stock (soda, beer can carrying cases)
- Junk Mail & Envelopes
- Paperback Books

### Don't Recycle:

- Motor oil, insecticide, herbicide or hazardous chemical containers
- Grocery or department store plastic bags
- Plastic film (plastic sheets, tarps, or wrap)
- Styrofoam, expanded foam or clear polystyrene
- Waxed Cardboard
- Metal clips, spirals, ring binders
- Plastic cards, stick on labels or unused stamps
- No hard cover books

## Unacceptable Items for General Trash

- Barrels
- Appliances
- Empty Tanks
- Hazardous Waste
- Liquids
- Paint, or Paint Cans (see below)
- Septic Waste
- Used Oil
- Construction Debris (pipes, board, drywall, ceiling tiles, sinks, tubs, shower surrounds, flooring)
- Carpet (can be picked up if rolled and tied and no longer than a 4-foot section)
- Electronic Waste
- Corrosive Waste
- Electronics
- Flammable Waste
- Fluorescent Bulbs
- Medical Waste
- Railroad Ties
- Tires
- Landscape Waste



## Bulky Items

Republic Services will pick up bulky items at no charge to the community every Tuesday. Bulky items are defined as household materials that are too large to fit in with your regular waste collection cart, such as furniture, mattresses, etc. Bulky items must be scheduled to be picked up. **Please email [atlantabulk@republicservices.com](mailto:atlantabulk@republicservices.com) to make sure your bulk item is picked up.**

## Frequently Asked Questions

- What if I generate more than the capacity of the cart?
  - An occasional overage can be picked up; simply put it close to your cart and we will collect. This is limited to 3 extra bags at up to 35lbs a bag.
- What happens if the cart breaks?
  - If your cart should happen to break please contact the Village Hall for a replacement cart-free of charge.
- Can I put loose trash in the cart?
  - No. All trash must be bagged and tied and then deposited in your cart. This practice will help keep your cart cleaner and minimize odor.
- Where do I place the cart at the curb? And does it have to face a certain way?
  - When you wheel your cart to the curb, the arrows on top of the lid should face towards the street. The wheels and handle need to face the house. Leave (1) one foot between the edge of the street and the cart. Leave (5) five feet of space between the cart and any vehicle. Leave (3) three feet of space between the cart and any other obstacles such as trees, mailboxes, basketball oles or other carts. See the diagram on previous page.
- What do I do with my cart if I move?
  - The carts stay at the address they were delivered to. Do not take your carts with you when you move, as they belong to Republic Services.
