

2022 Atlanta Trash Pickup

Trash will be picked up every Friday, with the exception of weeks with a holiday, when trash & recycling will be picked up on Saturday. The calendar on the left indicates trash pickup days (shaded) for the remainder of 2022.

Recycling Pickup

Recycleables will be picked up every other week, alternating between residences in 2 groups. Groups are defined by the maps below.

Group A (dates in squares) begins on August 5 and Group B (dates in ovals) begins on August 12.
